## **Utility Billing Changes**

Village Council & the Saskatchewan Municipal Board have approved a multi-year water rate increase. Rates are now \$19.50/minimum 1000 gallons and \$1.95/100 gallons over 1000. Effective May 1, 2016, the rates will increase again to \$20.50/1000 gallons and \$2.05/100 gallons over 1000. The sewer and waste rates will remain the same.

Starting January 1, 2016, the Utility Billing will change to quarterly billings. What this means, is that on December 31, 2015 you will receive your bill for December and then on March 31, 2016, you will receive your bill for January-February-March 2016. i.e. if you usually use the minimum for water, your monthly bill was \$59.50 and now your quarterly bill will be \$178.50. Of course, you can still pay your utility bills monthly towards your quarterly bill instead of waiting for the billing, if that works better for you. Payments options: Cash, Cheque, direct debit through the Prairie Centre Credit Union or E-Transfer (need village e-mail address only).

## **Noise Bylaw**
